Job Summary:

Experience clinician that serves as a resource in a defined specialty area. Assumes responsibility for coordinating agency programs, projects, and committees. Evaluates patients referred to physical therapy and develops and implements physical therapy plans.

Job Duties:

3. Evaluate referred patients. Develop and implement physical therapy treatment programs.
4. Develop and implement a comprehensive discharge plan in conjunction with the patient, family, and other health professionals.
5. Supervise the clinical aspects of care provided by technical and supportive personnel.
6. Participate in staff development activities.
7. Display a service oriented approach to patient care.
8. Follow hospital and departmental policies and procedures.
9. Communicate effectively with patients, visitors, fellow employees, and medical staff.
10. Ability to work hours required.
11. Ability to work with all levels of staff. Ability to plan effectively, organize and direct various activities with other departments.

13. **Perform all other duties as assigned by Director/supervisor.**

Education, Training and Experience Required:

Graduate from an accredited school of physical therapy. Must have current license issued by the State of Oklahoma Board of Physical Therapy Examiners. CPR certification required.

Physical Requirements:

- At times, lifts, moves, and support equipment and patients. Exposed to infection and odors. May be exposed to blood and body fluids, contaminated open wounds, various flammable chemicals, adhesive and electrical equipment in providing patient care. Must deal with patients and public on personal basis under all conditions. Talking and hearing to

converse with patients and staff members. Near visual acuity for accurate reading of gauges and recording patient information.

- Ability to perform tasks involving physical activity which may include assisting with lifting patients exceeding 150 pounds.
